**FMA - Who We Are:** FMA, founded in 2009, is an organization for pilots who are also musicians that welcomes all proficiency levels and musical genres. We ask that you direct people to the FMA website for membership information and then simply report back to the FMA Ambassador Coordinator ([Bruce Dunai](#)) monthly about the activities you or others have been able to participate at and what was done in the way of promoting FMA. Requested information would be event details, location, number of attendees, and info collected about prospective FMA members (name, address, email, phone, aviation and musical interests and activities) and potential FMA involvement in future events as well as student outreach.

    - a. When – when it is best for whomever is hosting
    - b. Where – in a hangar or FBO
    - c. Why – generate activity, awareness and comradery
    - d. Who – either host, co-host, or find someone in your area to host
    - e. Invite – musicians and pilots or whomever enjoys live music
      - i. Ask folks to bring a dish, drinks, etc.
      - ii. Have entertainer(s) to showcase
      - iii. Have a Sound Circle, Open Mic, Jam

**FMA Will Support You:** FMA will have material and speaker presentations in PowerPoint format that will be useful in making live presentations. Also, brochures, banners, sign-up sheets and other material are available that can be utilized when making live person presentations. FMA can also make contact prior, paving the way, with the lead organization for inclusion.

**Possible Future Events:** Make sure you are aware of activities via the FMA Radar as well as Social Flight events, FFAST events, AOPA Air Safety Foundation events, EAA events, seminars, etc. that are happening in your area. Ask the organizer if you or another member may take a few minutes to make a short presentation about FMA.
